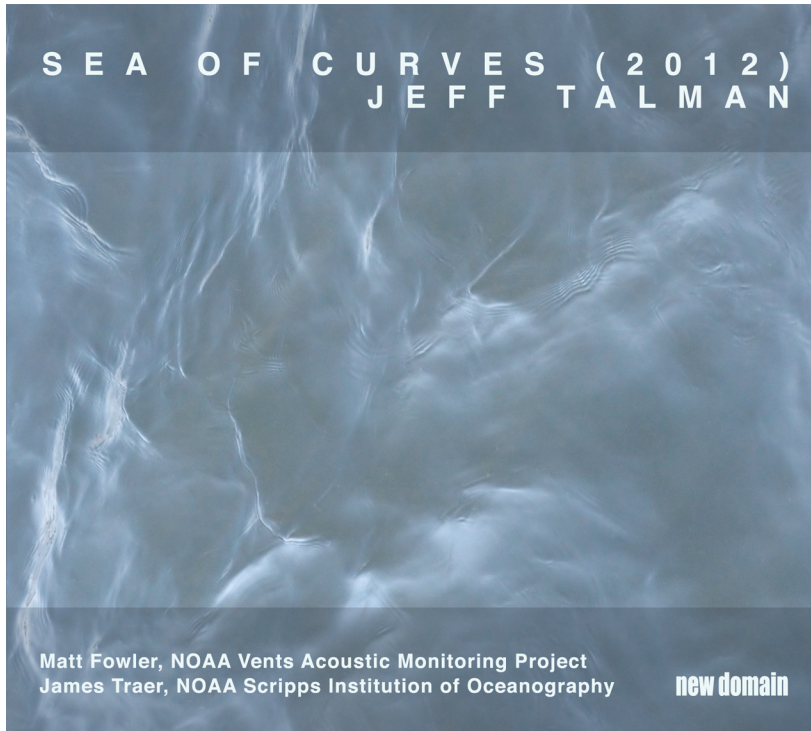

Voices of the Sea

Jeff Talman's *Sea of Curves* evokes the power and sensuality of the ocean while mirroring subtle inflections and dramatic shifts in light, transparency and mood as conjured by the sea. Project audio originates in ocean wave sounds recorded by hydrophone, seismometer and microphone in collaboration with Matt Fowler and James Traer, NOAA ocean researchers. Symphonic in scope, the work features the 'hum of the Earth,' the planetary sonic vibrations believed to be caused by worldwide impact of wave sounds on the sea floor.

Canadian and German Installations

Sea of Curves was first presented by the Pouch Cove Foundation in July 2012 as a multi-channel sound installation on a cliffside summer-thick field of clover with a panoramic view of the Atlantic Ocean in Newfoundland, Canada. Installation sound emerged from ocean wave sounds crashing on the rocks below. Künstlerhaus Dortmund, Germany then presented the installation in the February 2013 gallery exhibition *Voyage: sea journeys, island-hopping and trans-oceanic concepts*.

Recognized as a visionary pioneer in the use of resonance in art, Talman has created work internationally, including his installations in Cathedral Square-Cologne, Galleria Mazzini-Genoa, the MIT Media Lab, the Bavarian Forest and upcoming in Rothko Chapel, Houston. He was classically trained as a composer and eventually directed orchestras at Columbia University and City College, NYC. He began programming computers for sound in 1984. Talman has received numerous awards and fellowships including those from the Guggenheim Foundation, the New York Foundation for the Arts and the Corporation of Yaddo.
